Pump station—Dave again tried to reach Dennis. Dennis has yet to produce anything for us. Mr. Witt has yet to contact the District with concerns. We will possibly send a letter to Mr. Harris if we cannot move forward with Dennis. We hopefully will have something started by our October meeting. The bench mark will be part of the deal with Mr. Harris. We would like them on 4th, 9th and 12th/13th Streets. Dave and Shanna will get a short letter ready to pass to Tim and Larry to send if ok. Larry moves to send agreed upon letter to Dennis then follow with Mr. Harris if needed. Tim seconds. All in favor. Motion carried.

Walkway repairs—Dave called Unilliance and has yet to hear back from them.

Dave and Tim talked about Matt Heintz mowing possibly Tuesday or Thursday of next week. We would like it done before Labor Day.

Assessments—we received stamped copies of approval for the 2011 assessments of \$45K (same as last year). Dave talked with Mr. Maloney asking for requests/requirements of how Judge Winters would like things in the future. Mr. Maloney said that the Judge did not have any requests or requirements. Mr. Maloney's advice is to continue doing things as we have done for years. The

State and County Auditors, Treasurer, and the Judge are fine with the current way we do our assessments.

As stated at the hearing, if we do the walkways and no major projects are in the works, we may refigure our assessments next year.

New Business:

Mrs. Schank questions about people trapping marsh at the beginning of beach. The District only has easements. We do not own any property. Therefore, it would fall under the Sand Beach Association. If there are concerns, contact the SBA or Carroll Twp. Police.

Dave moves to hire Chris Andrassy to do our yearly survey. Tim seconds. All agreed. Motion carried. Chris Allman suggests that when we have our fall survey done maybe do a volumetric survey of all of the MBWG's to possibly build a 'portfolio'. Tim moves to have 1st through 8th streets surveyed along with 8th and 9th normal survey not to pass \$10K. After discussion, Dave amends motion to read if Mr. Andrassy believes that this is pertinent information for us to have and does not exceed the 10K, the Directors will then decide whether to move ahead with the additional surveying. Laura Schank states that she feels that this would breach the sunshine law with the directors discussing this outside of a meeting. There was more discussion, motion dies for lack of second. Dave will get an estimate on cost and the professional opinion from Mr. Andrassy if that would be worthwhile to have. This might be a possibility for next year.

The District's meeting falls on December 16th this year. Due to scheduling conflicts Dave moves to move the meeting to Monday, December 20th as long as the date works for the hall. Larry seconds. All in favor. Motion carried. We will have firm date after Shanna Contacts Mr. Gyde at the Carroll Twp Hall.

We have a listing of new engineers. We will pick the names closest to us and send a letter stating our needs and requesting them to respond with a resume. The list of Engineers is as follows: John Hancock and Associates, Lewandowski Engineering, Kesmer & Associates, Bowser & Morner, LTD., RE Warner, and Matrix Engineering. We hope to hear back by our December meeting. We will also request our files from Mr. Andrassy's wife.

Pump station—Mr. Harris has been in contact with Dave. Dennis doesn't really work for him anymore. Mr. Harris has been talking with Mark Witt (Jere Witt's son) and there is supposedly money out there for fighting the Phragmite weeds. Mr. Harris contacted Joe Young, his engineer, for a simple plan to fix the pump station. We have received copies of this plan. After the board has discussed these plans, we feel comfortable moving forward. Mr. Harris has already given a verbal go ahead several times.
