- 3. **Motion** by Thomas Schank and seconded by Ted Behnken to allocate \$4,000 to hire St Clair Excavating to fill low spots at various spots along the marsh to build up right of way at \$200 per load (approximately 10 loads) and leveling dirt at \$100 per hour (approximately 3 hours). Approved
- 4. The tree removal quote to Thomas Schank was a verbal of \$800. The President of the Sand Beach Association said he would look at the invoice from Great Lakes Tree Removal to see if some of those dollars were allocated from the SBCD. No motion was approved. Tabled to next meeting.

- Motion by Ted Behnken and seconded by Thomas Schank to authorize up to \$10,000 to Westlick Landscape or any other contractor to replace wood on First Street and Third Street decks. Approved.
- The Secretary was instructed to send an email message to Sand Beach owners a notice of the meeting one week prior. In that notice to advise owners of the agenda posted 24 hours prior to meeting on the web page under Agendas.
- 3. **Motion** by Ted Behnken and seconded by Thomas Schank to move the SBCD web page and all data to Word Pressed Hosting Services by January 2025 at the cost of \$400 per year. Approved.
- 4. **Motion** by Ted Behnken and seconded by Thomas Schank to revise the assessments for tax bills coming out in January 2025 to \$35,000. Approved.
- 5. After a lengthy discussion Ted Behnken withdrew the motion made at the August Board meeting to remove vegetation and do filling on the Sand Beach Road and 8th street right of way.

Discussion occurred on what area is being maintained by the SBCD and the Sand Beach Association. The area being driven on Is not owned by the SBA, and is owned by the owner of the marsh, and there is no easement.

The cost to clear the road is \$3500, plus dirt and leveling, \$5800 to fill the low area which is impassable. Tom asked Dan Schlagter, President of Sand Beach Association, to voice his opinion, which he stated all of his family is behind not doing it. Schlagter is opposed to it do since it could affect wildlife, and potentially affect his personal real estate.

The Sand Beach Association approved this project at their last meeting.

Tom Schank asked how the association was made aware of the project. Tom expressed that we only have 2 mandates to spend money, ie: Shoreline erosion and flood prevention. Director Clapp and Behnken disagreed with this interpretation. Director Schank stated that filling low areas is not in our original mandate. Paul Strouse, President, states that we do not have rights other than for flood structures. Director Clapp and Behnken disagreed.

Director Schank stated he was distressed that 2 board members would attend a meeting without discussion ahead of time. Director Clapp and Behnken disagreed, and stated it was clearly brought up at the prior District meeting, and voted on to approve money. Director Schank stated that consent of the land owner is not required, but pleased that we asked for permission ahead of the work. Director Schank stated he believes there is no need to do this work, and Director Behnken stated that having a secondary exit from the beach would enhance public safety. Director Clapp stated roads were removed many times during flooding, and a secondary exit would be appropriate for public ingress and egress. Director Behnken asked Mr Schlagter if he would have an objection to filing about 30 feet of the old road, as an alternative, which is currently very wet and unpassable.

After extensive discussion, Motion by Director Behnken withdrawn at this time. Director Clapp agreed. Project tabled.

Motion by Thomas Schank to hire a qualified expert hydrologist or engineer experienced in natural water flow to inspect the area and provide a report to the Board regarding what action if any should be taken on that item. The Motion was not seconded. (failed to get a second)

Next meeting is scheduled for December 19, 2024. Motion to adjourn by Ted Behnken and seconded by Thomas Schank. Approved.
