The Sand Beach Conservancy District is a political subdivision of the State of Ohio organized and existing pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6101. The Conservancy District was established under a decree of this Court issued pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 6101.08. The statutory purposes and functions of the Conservancy District include preventing floods, reclaiming or filling wet and overflowed lands, and arresting erosion along the portion of the Ohio shore line of Lake Erie located within the District. R.C. 6101.04.

There were six (6) meetings of the Sand Beach Conservancy District held in 2021. Copies of the Minutes of the meetings are attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated by reference. All meetings were open, public meetings, conducted in accordance with applicable law, and held in the Carroll Township Hall, Ottawa County, Ohio.

Pursuant to Revised Code Section 6101.44, all receipts of the Sand Beach Conservancy District are administered through a fund, the Maintenance Fund, which is the Conservancy District's only fund. The meeting was called to order by President Tim Clapp at 7:00 p.m. at the Carroll Township Hall on Zoom.

### **Committee Reports:**

- 1) Break Waters and Off Shore Protection Update: Director Schank reported that he contacted Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur's office about the status of the District's Letter of Request for the breakwaters. Her staff responded that they were checking with the Army Corp of Engineers to determine what was being done and to encourage support. Director Schank also requested a meeting among the District Directors and her Chief of Staff to brief them further on the need for breakwaters and encourage more active support. Her office has not respond to that request at this time. Director Schank will keep pursuing a meeting with the Congresswoman.
- 2) Director Schank also reported on a program being promoted buy the Ohio Department of Natural Resources that offers low interest long term loan support to private property owners on the Lake Erie shoreline to make improvement to their break walls and other shoreline protections. Under the program, adjacent property owners are encouraged to agree on particular solutions and if approved by ODNR, then collectively hire contractors to do installation. This program is not intended at this time for projects as large as breakwaters and strongly encourages property owners to agree to installation of public walkways on the break wall improvements.
- 3) Committee to Review all Works currently on Property in Sand Beach: Plan to have a committee to re-document SBCD Rocks/ blocks on owners'

property and have a photographic record and possibly mark them in some way.

The meeting was called to order by President Tim Clapp at 7:00 p.m. at the Carroll Township Hall on Zoom.

Board Members present: President Tim Clapp and Vice-President Ted Behnken, Board member Thomas Schank and Sara Hanselman-Secretary/Treasurer

Attendees: 6 attendees were on line via Zoom

**Motion** to approve the April 22, 2021, meeting minutes by Thomas Schank seconded by Ted Behnken. Approved.

Officers reports...Treasurer's Report as of June 24, 2021, Motion by Thomas Schank and seconded by Ted Behnken to approve Treasurer's report. Approved

Email for Funding for EMA by Tim Clapp for help on flood costs. Once received, we will accumulate bills and make a submission to EMA.

### Committee Reports:

- 1) Break Waters and Off Shore Protection update: Director Thomas Schank reported he sent an email to Chief Planning Officer on Flood issues. A request on an update on the off-shore breakwaters. It is currently in the Project List in the Section 205. It is in the Due course of review. It could be 1 to 2 years before we hear anything. Marci Kaptur's office is also in the loop on the project. There is a request to have a meeting with Kaptur or her staff.
- 2) Current review of projects in Sand Beach requiring attention, including barrier removals. The Wood Barriers were removed on 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Streets, and Clapp requested to SBA to inform members not to remove them without prior permission.

**Litigation Update:** Walter vs Sand Beach Association/ Sand Beach Conservancy: Tom Schank did an update on the Preliminary Injunction on the Walter Case. The judge expected to issue a ruling sooner than later.

Tom Schank stated no change in status of the Morgillo case.

- 1.) Dredging Project update:
  - a) Two areas of debris in the Marsh, by Bennice and Morgillo. Spearings shoved debris into the boatway/marsh. A letter should be sent by Secretary to Spearings informing them they should not put anything into the boatway or marsh.
  - b) Policy on obtaining material from 7<sup>th</sup> Street is located on Sand Beach cd.com. Owners are allowed to get fill and must follow the guidelines.
  - c) Unillance shall be leveling 7th street in July or August.
  - d) Part of the culvert at 9<sup>th</sup> street washed out and needs to be put back together.
- 2.) Emergency Project on Sand Beach Road at 12<sup>th</sup> Street. There is a Cost of Blocks of approximately \$4000. Shortridge can haul 7 per truck, 68 (6 footers). This includes Trucking. We may need to purchase additional blocks (2x4) for bottom row.
  Motion by Thomas Schank to purchase 68 blocks at Dike Road Project at 12<sup>th</sup> St. Seconded by Ted Behnken. Approved
- 3.) Emergency Project on 13<sup>th</sup> Street. A preliminary design and request to hire BEC to design the 13<sup>th</sup> St project. Concern is to have equipment access. The access is only 20 feet wide. Schank proposed we also talk to other contractors, like Rick Shortridge or Unilliance for their thoughts on design. Motion by Thomas Schank to consult BEC on design. Seconded by Behnken, Approved
- 4.) Auditor's report given to Directors. Audit passed with no issues except executive sessions must note the specific reasons for Executive sessions.

**NEW BUSINESS:** 

- 1) Directors Position report: Director's position held by Behnken. Action taken: 124 postcards mailed to all in the district, ad in The Beacon for 4 consecutive weeks and letter sent to Judge Winters.
- 2) Public Records Custodian form was signed by President Tim Clapp for the record.
- 3) Flood issues: Recap of May 28<sup>th</sup> Flood: Both pumps were turned on. During the storm, the marsh rose several feet. Unillance was contacted on emergency call, to bring 25 blocks and fill holes going through to the marsh. The Association worked well with us and things went very well. Streets were being cleaned in the middle of the storm. Cleanup took approximately 3 weeks to complete, not including road damage.
- 4) Storm cleanup invoices & cost share with SBA. Motion by Thomas Schank and seconded by Ted Behnken to pay the bills billed to SBCD and then ask SBA for 50% of the cleanup bills. Approved
- 5) SBA paving of Dike road: SBA President reported they approved at last meeting to repave Dike Road as well as the area damaged by storm on 9<sup>th</sup> street at Morgillos.
- 6) Current status of the Dike Road Project of 1987 effectiveness. The SBA was hesitant at their meeting to pave Dike Road due to water infiltration between the blocks.
  Subsequently, The Three Directors reviewed the 1987 project drawings and the current state of the Rip Rap and Blocks in person. The in person review found the wall and Rip Rap are still pretty much intact as designed. Yet, there was evidence of water spurting thru the cracks in the blocks, forming a 1 to 2 foot area of minimal washout of the stone on the south side.

Per Review, the slope is 2 to 1 and the rip rap runs about 14 to 16 feet. The Sand Beach Road (at Dike Road) was built to a 578 elevation. The last time it was paved was in The top row of blocks are set at 582 which meets the current design as recommended by the Engineer. The Slope was designed for 2 to 1 and the rip rap stone is about 14 to 16 foot. This appears to be the intact from the 1987 installation. There are small cracks between the blocks that could have concrete grouted in to stop the spurts.

The SBCD per Tim Clapp paved the road in 1995.

The SBCD District has prioritized adding and resetting blocks on Dike Road at 12<sup>th</sup> St first, Second on 13<sup>th</sup>, and last to repairing the spurting on Dike Rd.

- 7) Tim Clapp maintenance: Motion by Ted Behnken and seconded by Thomas Schank to approve Tim Clapp's bill for repairs of steps in the amount of \$209.63 Approved.
- 8) Rework of 9<sup>th</sup> Street Sand Projection: **Motion** by Ted Behnken and seconded by Thomas Schank to put 6 foot blocks in front of the steel. Move the 4 blocks there already and add more blocks to make it two high. Motion to install blocks approximately 10. Motion passed.

### Break Waters and Off Shore Protection update: Thomas Schank

There is no update from the Army Corp since June but this is expected as their process is very deliberative. I am continuing to stay in contact with them and Congressperson Kaptur's office. The State of Ohio through recent legislation has established an ODNR grant program for shoreline erosion prevention that evaluates proposed projects for funding. The District can and will apply for funds in the 2022-2023 period for breakwater support. Unfortunately, the total funding for all approved projects for this year is only \$5 million and the program does not specifically identify breakwaters as typical projects. This is likely due to the cost of breakwaters. As the project moves through Army Corp review, we will contact professional services to support possible solicitations for grants to support the breakwater costs when approval is achieved.

#### **Unfinished Business:**

- 1) Block purchase follow up. Motion by Thomas Schank to allocate \$15,000 for the purchase of 78 blocks (\$50 per block, 6 truck loads, delivery and unload) from Nissen. Seconded by Ted Behnken. Approved.

Instead Walter waited until the 28<sup>th</sup> day, then filed an appeal. As part of that action Walter asked Judge Winters to stay his order which the Judge denied. The Conservancy arranged for Uniliance to remove the blocks on the 32<sup>nd</sup> and 33rd days following the judgment. Walter consented to the removal of the blocks by Conservancy prior to their removal. The appeal is still pending but is likely mooted by the Walter consent to the move.

Morgello: no change

### Break Waters and Off Shore Protection update: Thomas Schank

The Board received a report from Director Schank on the status of the Breakwaters Project submitted to the Army Corp of Engineers. The Corp informed Director Schank recently that I will begin the review process of submitted projects after the first of the year to select those to be considered in the next funding cycle. All submissions nationwide are considered and selections are made on a nationwide basis. Notwithstanding this approach, it is likely that

some projects from each Corp region will be selected for evaluation. There will be no action or additional information from the Corp until these processes are completed, probably in the second quarter of 2022.

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
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


